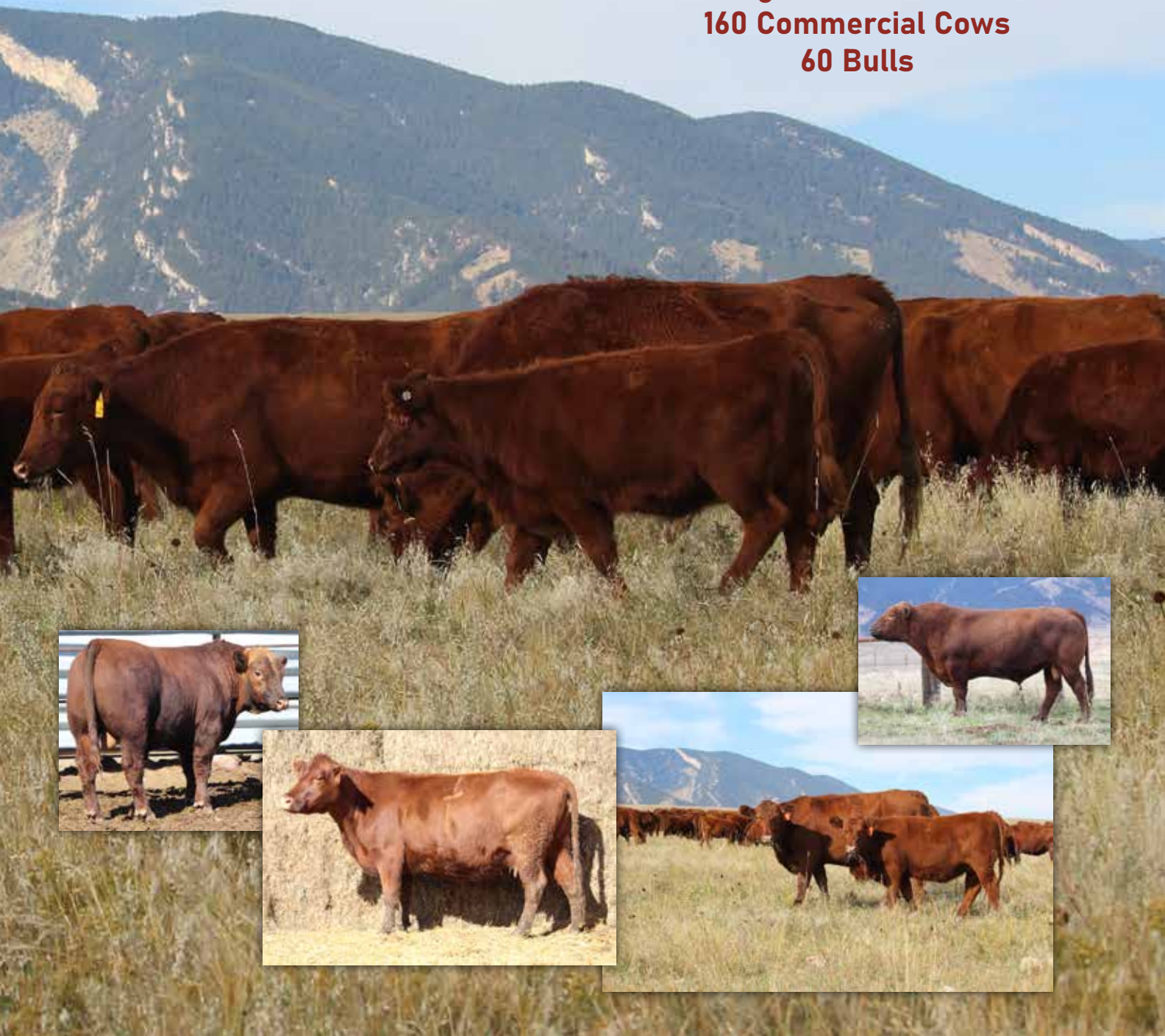

Dear Friends and Cattlemen,

On behalf of my family and all of us here at Beckton, we want to welcome you to Beckton's first fall production sale in many years. Several factors came together to prompt this sale, but they add up to 'we have too many good cows'.

To start with we haven't sold our top-producing, prime age cows in many years. Every year we add replacement heifers that move our genetics forward, but at some point females have to go. Now we simply have too many prime and proven age Registered cows with great production records, and that still have good years of production left. Our cows can produce to fifteen or sixteen years of age or more. We hope to find good homes for these ladies where they can still keep producing calves, as these are elite cows and donor prospects. We have 75 of these girls and have them grouped in 35 lots, and we are letting you pick.

The same thing has happened on the bull side. We breed almost entirely natural service, so we use a lot of bulls, and we add 15 or more yearling bulls every year to use with our replacement heifers. We turn our bull genetics very rapidly to keep moving our herd forward, and don't necessarily want them going back on their own daughters. These are herd sire caliber bulls that we originally selected for our own replacements. They are young, starting at just three years old, and have many years of good service still ahead.

Finally, we have younger bulls from our 2022 crop that are now 18 months of age, going to be two next spring, and ready to go to work. All of the USDA and Cattlefax inventory numbers say the cow and calf numbers are going to be lower next year, and bull sale supplies are likely lower also. Getting bulls now for 2024 needs is probably the best investment any market offers.

Once again we welcome you to our sale. You will be able to bid through Superior Livestock, but if you can come in person we would like very much to have you.

Some Facts about the Beckton Herd

Beckton has long been one of America's premier breeders recognized for genetics which combine a genuine balance of desirable traits - calving ease, maternal traits, and rapid growth to yearling age. They are a leading choice for commercial replacement females and for building a great cow herd. And the lower birth weights make them a first choice for breeding heifers.

HERD STAYABILITY: Beckton is the #1 Herd in the Red Angus breed for Stayability, and has been for many years. 15 of the top 20 highest ranking sires in the breed for **Stayability EPD** are Beckton sires or descended from Beckton sires.

EASY CALVING: Beckton has long been the choice for easy calving sires that still have gain and growth. **9 of the top 10** highest ranking sires in the breed for **Calving Ease EPD** (and 44 of the top 50 sires) are Beckton sires or descended from Beckton sires.

CARCASS QUALITY: For **Marbling EPD**, **8 of the top 10 highest ranking sires** (and 44 of the top 50 sires) are Beckton sires or descended from Beckton sires. Beckton genetics are very popular for grass fed and natural beef programs. Raised and developed on our short grass and mountain pastures here in northern Wyoming, and upgraded from Angus origins, they are a natural source for these private beef marketing programs. We have regular bull customers from California to Texas to Maine and most states in between, who want our genetics for **easy marbling, early maturity, ability to gain on grass and roughage, and high scoring beef tenderness.**

MODERATE MATURE SIZE: One characteristic of Beckton cattle which makes them ideal for producing replacement females and building a low cost, efficient cowherd, is the **moderate mature size**. Page 5 shows the results of decades of genetic selection. We believe we have the best genetics for **Efficiency** that can be found anywhere.

Sale Information

Details

Health Program: Beckton has a comprehensive herd-wide health program which includes vaccinations for 7-Way, IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV, Lepto, and ivermectin. The heifers are also vaccinated for bangs and vibrio.

Fertility Tested: All bulls have passed a rigorous fertility exam that included live semen evaluation, scrotal measurements, and reproductive tract examinations.

All Bulls "Trich" Tested: In all the years we have been selling and delivering bulls, Beckton has never had a bull test positive for "trich". But because an increasing number of states require testing of yearling bulls, and to avoid any delay in delivery time, we will have all the sale bulls tested negative for "trich" prior to the sale. Customers from any state may also come to the sale with their trailer and load out directly after the sale.

Osteopetrosis Tested: When a genetic test was developed by RAAA for osteopetrosis (OS), Beckton tested every sire in use in our program, as well as our major AI sires. Every Beckton bred sire (nearly 80 in total) tested OS Free.

Semen Interest Retention: Buyer receives full possession and one half semen interest in all the bulls in the catalog. Seller is retaining one half interest in all bulls in the catalog. This is done so we can use some of the bulls in herd and reserve the right to collect and market semen on these bulls. Any collection on our behalf would be at our expense and could be done during the off-season and at the convenience of the buyer. The buyer would have the option to share in the collection and retain semen for the buyer's use also. If semen is marketed by either party, Seller receives one half royalty interest on gross semen sales, and buyer receives one half interest. Regardless of semen collection and marketing, the buyer retains full possession, full pasture use rights, and full salvage value in these bulls.

Free Delivery: Four or more Registered females will receive 1000 miles free delivery, with additional distance at cost. All other sale animals are delivered at cost.

Payment: Payments can be made with cash, check payable to Beckton Stock Farm, Inc. or Visa/Mastercard on sale day.



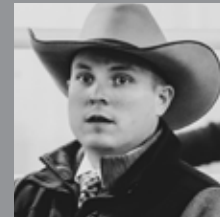

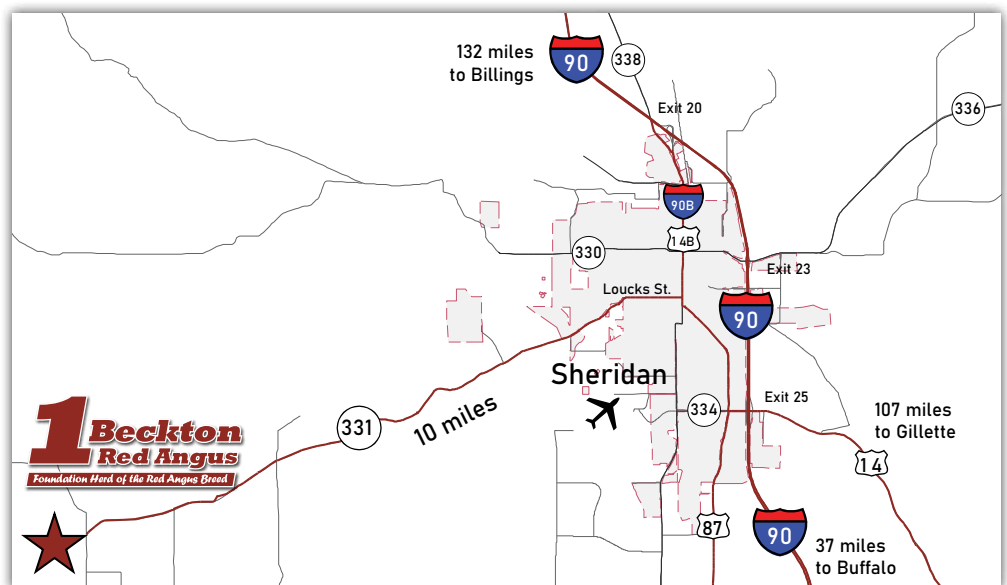

How to Participate as an Absentee Bidder

Buyers purchasing via Superior or Pelton Livestock can mail a check after the sale with brief delivery instructions and an approximate date you would like delivery by. If you would like to pay with a credit card, please call the office the day after the sale.

1. Site-Unseen Purchase

If you are unable to attend the sale, we can help you select the bulls or heifers to fit your needs. Give us a call, letter, fax or email, and we can handle bidding for you according to your directions. Satisfaction is guaranteed on all animals purchased "sight-unseen". Over a quarter of our bulls sell this way, mostly to long-time and repeat customers. To provide adequate time to assist you, please contact us before sale day.

2. Superior Livestock Productions: Two Options

Pre-register at www.superiorlivestock.com prior to the sale, and then select one of the following methods to bid:

Turn in Bids Over the Phone. To get started simply go online to www.superiorlivestock.com and click on the tab titled "Register for a Buyer Number". Select the registration form for Superior Productions and print the registration form, fill it out and fax it in to Superior Productions at 817-378-3380 with a signature on it, or scan and email the form to

info@superiorauction.com. You can also mail it in to the address provided on the form. Upon receipt of this information Superior will call you with a buyer's number and the bid line phone number that you will use on sale day to place bids over the phone.

OR

Online Click-To-Bid. This is Superior's online bidding platform for cattle buying. Please note that high speed internet is required - this is not for dial-up or satellite internet. Registration is free, but you must become a member of www.superiorclicktobid.com to sign up. Becoming a member is easy - just go to the homepage of www.superiorclicktobid.com and follow the out-lined steps to get started. Input your information and select a username and password. You will receive an e-mail confirming you are a member. From that point forward you just have to sign in and select the sale you would like to register for and once approved you will receive an e-mail confirming which sale you are now registered for.

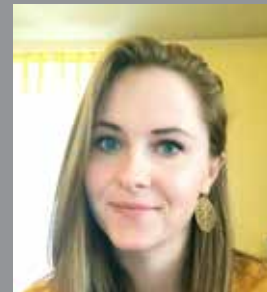

Beckton's Efficiency Gain

Over the past 45 years, Beckton has been selecting for increased early rate of growth (to slaughter age) while holding cow weights constant. We have accomplished this by selecting for growth, restricting birth weight and cow size creep, and using rapid generation turnover to multiply each incremental change rapidly throughout our entire cowherd and all of our bloodlines. We have seen a dramatic increase in economic efficiency. **Our average cow weighs about 96% of what she weighed in 1978, but our average yearling weight is 128% of what it was in 1978.**

The U.S. cattle industry has also been increasing average steer slaughter weights, but industry-wide there has been no effort to control cow size. It turns out that industry cow weights are increasing at about the same percentage as steer and heifer slaughter weights. (Industry-wide, cows weigh 129% and steers weigh 133%, compared to 1978 weights). **Over 45 years, there has been minimal improvement in overall cow herd efficiency.** The increase in growth and value of market animals is being largely offset by the increase in feed requirements and maintenance cost of the mother cow herd.

The accompanying graphic shows the increase in efficiency of Beckton cattle compared to the U.S. beef industry. In the promotion of composites, the impact of retained heterosis on mature weight is too often ignored. Cross-breeding and composite breeding have done little more than simply increase general cattle size. Crossbreeding and composites are sold as a free lunch, but they aren't free.

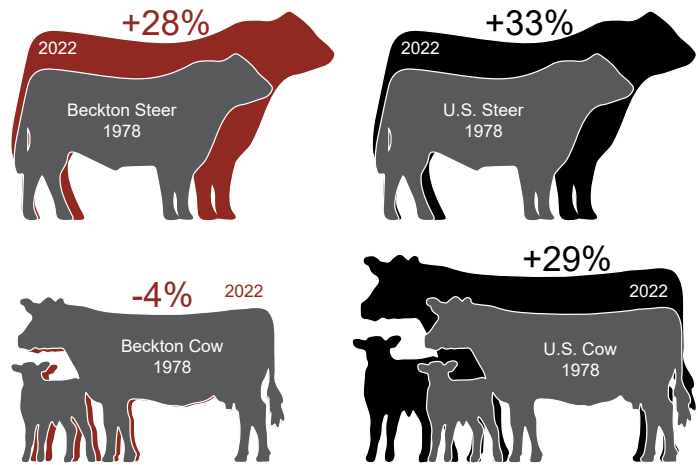
Cow Efficiency

We present two indicators of efficiency. The first is Weaning Percent, a simple percentage of calf 205 day weight divided by the dam's actual weight at weaning. The second is PRI Cow Efficiency. This also measures calf weaning weight, but relative to the cow's metabolic weight, and is expressed as an index above or below 100.

These efficiency measures are best used as indicators of where an animal is relative to others, rather than directly for selection. For example, if we see an animal with a low efficiency, we would look at the actual calf and cow weights to decide if the calf is too small, or the cow too big for the environment. That in turn will suggest corrective actions. In general, select for the traits you need to change to make cattle more efficient, and efficiency will be the result.

Dam Information

A major difference with our catalog is the greater amount of information about the dams we provide. Weaning percent and Cow Efficiency are explained above. In addition, with each sale animal we give the dam's age when this calf was born, and the dam's actual weight when the calf was weaned the previous fall. We also provide her progeny averages – the average birth weight, weaning ratio, and yearling ratio – of her calves.

Beckton Performance

- Birth weight**
 - ★ Every sire entering our own program is used first on our own heifers, then on our cows.
 - ★ We have never used high birth weight sires in any part of our program, so big birth weights are rare.
 - ★ We get the pay weight, but with lower birth weights and greater calving ease.
 - ★ Full production from heifers. We use the same bulls on heifers and cows.
- Growth**
 - ★ Weaning efficiency, and rate of gain to slaughter weight second to none.
 - ★ Growth traits must be consistent with maintaining maternal qualities.
 - ★ Beckton cattle are ideally sized for today's packer demand.
- Hardiness**
 - ★ Every cow in the herd has spent part of her life in the Big Horn Mountain summer range, at elevations from 7000 to 10,500 feet.
 - ★ In 2001 we PAP tested all of our herd sires. The herd average PAP score was 32.5 at 4000', equivalent to a herd average PAP of 39 at 8000' (excellent scores).
 - ★ By the time she is 5, our average cow will have been trailed over 80 miles, above and beyond normal pasture rotation.
- Efficiency**
 - ★ The typical dam of our bulls weans over 50% of her body weight in 205 days, under range conditions, with no creep-feeding.
 - ★ The average dam produces over 100% of her own body weight in a year.
- Fertility**
 - ★ Every bull in our program is used in natural service, with 30-50 heifers/cows.
 - ★ Every cow in our program must cycle naturally and breed early under range conditions.
- Value**
 - ★ Beckton Red Angus produce more growth without high birth weights.
 - ★ They are the one-bull solution that can be used on both heifers and cows.
 - ★ Carcass quality is an extra benefit.
- Reliability**
 - ★ Beckton has been genetically improving Red Angus since 1945, a 30-60 year lead time over other producers.
 - ★ It is a complete, genetically sound breeding program, which demands whole-herd performance.

Beckton History

Beckton is one of the oldest ranches in the Sheridan, Wyoming area. It came into Forbes family ownership in 1899, and has grown since then. The home ranch lies in the foothills of the Bighorn Mountains, near the original Bozeman Trail. The site of the current ranch headquarters once included a post office and flour mill, founded by George Beck, from whom came the name "Beckton". George Beck's house, built in 1887, now serves as the Beckton ranch office.

In 1936, Waldo Forbes took over management of the Forbes family ranch. Waldo was interested in applying to beef cattle the ideas of performance testing and genetic selection for economically important traits. Waldo married Sal in 1939, just before World War II, and the two of them embarked on the undertaking that would make a contribution to the future direction of the beef industry — the establishment of an entirely new breed of cattle to be based on selection by performance traits of economic importance.

They bought top red calves from 18 leading registered Black Angus herds across the United States, using these red cattle to build the foundation herd of a new breed that was independent of existing breed associations. During the next decade, Beckton added many more red bulls and females from registered Black Angus herds. From early on, Beckton was active with crossbreeding their new Red Angus sires into their existing commercial Hereford herd, to create dual herds — one purebred Red Angus, and the other high-percentage Red Angus from the Hereford base. Today the two herds run side-by-side, sharing the use of our Red Angus sires.

In 1954 this new breed was formally established when the Red Angus Association of America was founded with performance testing as the cornerstone of breed improvement. Waldo served as the first president of the association until his death at the end of 1955. Sal served as the association's first Executive Secretary.

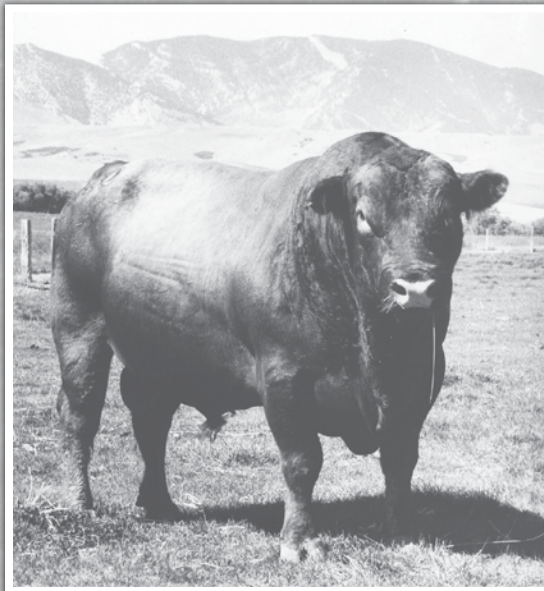
Today Beckton is the oldest and one of the largest Red Angus herds in the country, running approximately 1050 mother cows, 350 replacement females, and 100+ bulls (as

well as several hundred deer and elk) on 15,000 deeded and State lease acres. Each year, much of the cowherd is moved to high mountain pastures in mid-summer. The ranch grows all its own hay, primarily as grass-alfalfa mixes.

The forage and other resources are managed as much for information as for production. Simply put, we don't manage the cattle to maximize weaning weights or even conception rates. Our business is maximizing information; therefore the cattle are pushed far beyond industry norms. For example, 90% of the main cowherd is bred in single sire pastures at a rate of 40-50 cows per bull. The other 10% of the cowherd is bred AI. Heifers are divided into groups of 20-30 per bull. All yearling bulls potentially

entering our program are used with a heifer group first, for comparative progeny testing and calving ease evaluation. Every bull in our program must be able to be used without difficulty on first-calf heifers as well as older cows.

Likewise, the stocking rate we use is higher than other purebred or commercial ranches would use in our area. The

high stocking rate plus the scattered nature of our pastures and the high mountain ground, means the cattle are moved frequently. We once calculated that by the time she is five, our average cow has been trailed (not trucked) over 100 miles.

Our product is a package of genetic improvements which contribute to the production efficiency of other growers, both commercial and purebred. The value of our product derives from the information we can provide about its likely performance, combined with the reliability and consistency of our quality control. We use random mating almost exclusively to get meaningful and statistically unbiased data.

We believe that the most important livestock component of a commercial ranch is its cowherd, the focus of nearly all ranch costs. The cow is a production unit, with a set of costs attached, so the data we collect has to relate to the economics of that unit. The overwhelming share of operating costs depends on the quantity of feed required, not on the number of cows being run. For example, the cost of building and maintaining fence depends on the size of the pasture, not on the number of cows within the pasture. A focus on production efficiency has kept our cow size quite stable over the years. Birth EPD's give us an effective selection tool for managing mature size. We have also steadily improved the post-calving, pre-slaughter growth rate.

In summary, we have four basic production goals; to maximize the validity, usefulness and repeatability of our genetic information; to maximize the health and lifetime production capabilities of the animals we sell; to maximize the sustainability of our own natural resources, and to do all these things in the most efficient and cost-effective way possible. Ultimately, our success is measured by the success of the commercial beef producers who use our genetics.

Buyer's Choice of Yearling Heifers



LOTS A and B – Buyer's Choice of from one to twenty head from 180+ Beckton Registered bred 18 month old replacement heifers. This will be a private auction conducted by email directly with Beckton, commencing on the sale date Dec. 5 and continuing in the days thereafter until the First Choice and Runner-up buyers are determined.

LOT A

Winning Bidder Choice from 180+ Beckton Registered Red Angus 18 month old, replacement heifers. The winning bidder may select his or her choice of from one up to twenty head at the bid price.

LOT B

Runner-up Bidders' Choice from 180+ Beckton Registered Red Angus 18 month old, replacement heifers after LOT A selections have been made. A maximum total of 20 heifers will be sold in LOT A and LOT B.

LOT A / LOT B SELLING PROCEDURE

Prospective buyers should contact us directly and register on or before sale day (Dec. 5) to obtain a listing of the replacement heifers. Our replacement heifers will be available for direct viewing here at Beckton before, on and after our Dec. 5 sale date. At the sale more complete information will be provided to buyers who have registered, so that bidders may examine the performance records of the heifers while they are viewing. Prospective buyers who have registered but are not present at the sale may request this information via email.

Prospective buyers must submit an opening bid either in person or via email by the day of the sale in order to continue to bid. The subsequent bidding will be conducted via email and will be confidential with Beckton. Beckton will notify active bidders by email of the current high bid as it changes. Beckton will not disclose the names of any individuals bidding.

Bidding will continue until there is no increase in the bids for 72 hours. Beckton reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Buyers do NOT need to indicate the number of heifers that they are interested in during the bidding process, as that may depend on final price. Once the winning bidder is determined, he or she may select from 1 to 20 specific heifers that they wish to purchase at that price. Once those heifers are selected, the remaining heifers, up to a total of 20 head, are available to the highest Runner-up bidder(s) bidding on LOT B. Remaining heifers, up to 20, will be selected by the Runner-up bidder(s) in order of bid price.

Bidders submit bids in person or by email to Beckton, and may bid on either, or both, of LOT A (guaranteed first choice of all heifers) or LOT B (runner-up selections of all heifers still available after the LOT A selections have been made). A buyer may submit bids for both LOT A and LOT B simultaneously and the bids can be different (eg. submit a higher bid for LOT A and a lower bid for LOT B).

Lots C-1 through C-4 are High Percentage Red Angus sired by Beckton Registered Red Angus sires. Every cow had a calf last spring. They are bred and pregnancy tested, pasture exposed to Beckton Red Angus sires. The high bidder for each group may select a gate cut of 6 or more head from that group. Bring your trailer, or several trailers!

Except for those stated in the terms and conditions below, there are no warranties, either expressed or implied, as to the merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose with respect to the cattle being sold at this auction. The warranties and guarantees set forth in the "Terms and Conditions" are in lieu of all other warranties, either expressed or implied, and the remedies provided therein shall be the sole and exclusive remedy for the Buyer, or any party claiming through Buyer, for any breach of warranty or guarantee therein provided, and all other obligations or liabilities.

The information in the catalog is believed to be accurate, and the information seller believes to be most representative. It is the nature of seller's business that the seller engages in a continual process of collecting new data and information. Therefore, any information presented at the time of sale is always subject to revision, correction or update.

I. BIDDING

The Auctioneer in charge will settle any disputes as to bids, and his decision on such matters shall be final.

II. TERMS

Terms of sale are cash or personal check unless satisfactory credit arrangements have been made with vendor prior to sale.

III. PURCHASER'S RISK

Each animal becomes the risk of the purchaser as soon as sold, but it shall be the obligation of the Seller to see that animals are fed and cared for free of charge to purchaser, until loaded for shipment or until the expiration of 48 hours after the sale, whichever occurs sooner.

IV. DELIVERY

For any animals for which seller's arrange delivery, the following terms shall apply. Each animal becomes the risk of the purchaser as soon as sold, and through the time of delivery. The seller will arrange transportation and delivery schedules, and may combine animals from one or more purchasers for convenience and to reduce costs. If delivery is arranged, seller assumes no other liability. Once the purchaser has been notified of the date and approximate time of delivery (morning, afternoon, evening, etc.), it is the responsibility of the purchaser to arrange adequate and agreeable location and facilities for unloading each animal. When unloaded at the agreed upon location, all care and management of the animal is the responsibility of the purchaser.

V. CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY

A transferred certificate of registry will be furnished to the purchaser for each animal for which a Registration number is listed.

VI. HEALTH

All animals are eligible for interstate shipment, except as otherwise announced. Interstate health papers will be furnished for each animal requiring T.B, Bang's, and trich tests in accordance with federal and state regulations.

VII. DIVISIBILITY

The percentage of ownership interest received by the buyer, whether it is 100% or 2/3 or otherwise as defined in the catalog or by the auctioneer, may not be subsequently divided without the express written consent of the seller.

VIII. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Any changes from information of any kind in this catalog will be announced from the auction box and such announcements shall take precedence.

IX. BREEDING GUARANTEE

Any female that has had a calf prior to the date of sale shall be considered a breeder without further guarantee. All females sold as 'bred' or 'pregnant' have been pregnancy checked by a licensed veterinarian and are guaranteed bred on the day of sale. The purchaser may elect to have any female so listed rechecked at their cost within 30 days of delivery by a licensed veterinarian of their choice. Any such female determined open by this recheck may be returned to the seller for a full refund. Due to conditions out of seller's control, once a female leaves seller's possession, this is the only guarantee offered.

All bulls are sold as guaranteed breeders. Each bull has been officially fertility tested as "Satisfactory Breeder" prior to the sale. However, seller cannot guarantee against physical injury or illness following the sale. But if within 8 months following the sale, the buyer has evidence that the animal is not a breeder, the buyer may obtain a statement signed by a licensed veterinarian to that effect, such statement also indicating that there has been no injury or illness to the animal following the sale, and return the bull to the farm of the seller for adjustment. If the seller cannot then prove the animal to be a breeder, an adjustment will be made by the seller, either by substituting an animal of equal value, or by the refund of the full purchase price. Such adjustment shall be considered full settlement and satisfaction of all claims. No guarantees apply to animals which are shown following the sale.

X. GENETIC DEFECT GUARANTEE AND PARENTAGE

All parentage and pedigrees presented in the catalog are believed accurate based upon the breeding and DNA information we have available. However, parentage and pedigree information cannot be guaranteed 100%, because it is always possible that new information or new DNA technology and testing might show that there have been inadvertent errors.

Osteopetrosis: The Red Angus Association along with animal scientists have developed a DNA marker test for osteopetrosis (OS), a genetic disorder which in rare instances can cause the loss of a calf at birth. Since the test was developed, Beckton has tested every sire being used in our breeding program. Only one sire, from outside our program, tested positive as a carrier of the gene. Every sire bred and raised at Beckton has tested 'Free'. All of our major semen sires have also been tested 'Free'. We guarantee every sale animal to be OS Free, and if you have a concern, we will have any sale animal tested on request. If an animal were to test positive, we would replace the animal or refund the purchase price. The testing we have done shows no incidence of occurrence in any Beckton bloodlines for the past 30 years, and so we believe there is no safer herd than ours.

XI. RETAINED INTEREST AND SEMEN RIGHTS:

Beckton is selling full possession and one half semen interest in all the bulls in the catalog. Seller is retaining one half interest in all bulls in the catalog. This is done so we can use some of the bulls in herd and reserve the right to collect and market semen on these bulls. Any collection on our behalf would be at our expense and could be done during the off-season and at the convenience of the buyer. The buyer would have the option to share in the collection and retain semen for the buyer's use also. If semen is marketed by either party, Seller receives one half royalty interest on gross semen sales, and buyer receives one half interest. Regardless of semen collection and marketing, the buyer retains full possession, full pasture use rights, and full salvage value in these bulls.
